NEW VETERAN Tax Exemption

All Veterans (as of now, the definition of a "veteran" is anyone with a DD-214 that shows Honorable Discharge) who are residents of New Jersey can get a \$3,000 personnel tax deduction from their income on STATE taxes for 2017. In order to get this deduction, the Veteran needs to submit a copy of their DD-214 and a form to the NJ Division of Taxation. The below link has all of the info and the form.

Please note that

- the website says that it may take up to 3 months for this to be processed, so don't wait until April 15th to submit it.
- you have to print the form, sign it, and then scan it as a pdf in order to submit it on line. If you submit it online, then you will get 3 emails: confirmation that you submitted it; confirmation Taxation received it; and then a claim number from Taxation.
