B. Committee Secretary Warren Williams, presented to the committee with updated information pertaining to the Caregivers Program. The U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs(VA) Program of Comprehensive Assistance for Family Caregivers (PCAFC) offers enhanced clinical support for Family Caregivers of eligible veterans who incurred or aggravated a serious injury in the line of duty, including a scrious illness, along with other eligibility criteria. Changes to the program result from the new "Program of Comprehensive Assistance for Family Caregivers Improvements and Amendments under the VA Mission Act of 2018" Final Rule, RIN 2900-AQ48, effective October 1, 2020. These changes include:

- Expanding eligibility for Program of Comprehensive Assistance for Family Caregivers (PCAFC).
- Offering legal and financial services for designated Primary Family Caregivers of eligible Veterans.
- Making other changes affecting program eligibility and VA's evaluation of Program of Comprehensive Assistance for Family Caregivers (PCAFC) applications.
